

Job: Nursery Worker

Reports to: Director of Formation

<u>Job Description:</u> To provide safe, welcoming, and developmentally appropriate general care, and Christian formation for infants and toddlers during Sunday morning worship services.

Compensation: \$22, Hourly

Work Schedule: 4 Hours per week on Sunday Mornings.

## Required Qualifications:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Have a High School Diploma.
- Have experience working with preschool children.
- Be in good health, able to bend, stoop, lift, and physically take care of children.
- Complete "safe church" and Background Check upon hire.
- Maintain current first aid and CPR certification.
- Comfortable working in a Religious Environment.

## Responsibilities:

- 1. Remain up to date on "Safe Church" Online Certification Class, and Saint Andrew's Background Check. Maintain behavior that is consistent with "Safe Church training"
- Provide nursery care to children that is age appropriate. This could involve leading nursery formation activities.
- 3. Take attendance and ensure that parents/guardians sign children in and out of the nursery while also collecting information for the child's well being while in childcare. (ex: contact information, allergies etc.)

- 4. Give each child the attention needed to assure his/her welfare. (This relates to eating, toileting, sleeping, playing, healthcare, safety etc.)
- 5. Be familiar and follow the established policies and procedures.
- 6. Maintain a clean and orderly room.
- 7. Inform the Director of Formation of needed supplies, repairs and materials.
- 8. Make careful observation and written notations of significant behaviour of children for whom you are responsible, and report back to the parent/guardian or Director of Formation when appropriate.
- 9. Work with fellow Staff or Volunteers to distribute duties and work together.
- 10. Other duties pertinent to nursery care, as assigned by the Director of Formation.
